

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SERVICE NEWS Mark & Donna Crick

Greetings Motorcaders,

Donna and I are so glad winter has slipped away, and spring is now upon us. For those of us that aren't lucky enough to be traveling full time, the thought of getting back on the road lingers in the back of our minds. As does that "To Do" list that has to be finished to get the coach ready to hit the road.

If you're like me and didn't service your engine last fall, (I'm the "King of Procrastination"- just ask Donna or Beverly for that matter), now is the time to get it done!

Along with changing oil and filter, lubricating the chassis, and checking fluid levels, don't forget your air filter! While we were at the recent Mid-South Rally, the subject of servicing, or for that matter, over-servicing, the Air Filter came up. During that discussion, many of you ask if I thought the Filter Minder, the airflow restriction gage which Foretravel installs on the remote start/stop panel in the engine compartment, even worked. My answer was yes! But the reason most of us don't see it move is that we are changing the air filter before it "needs to be replaced".

Let me explain. The air filter in your coach is a heavy-duty dry-type filter media, made of paper, and allows air flow through its fibers so the filter media has to be made with "small holes" in it. If that's the case.

how does it work, you ask? If the filter paper was made to tight, the initial restriction of air would be too high, causing it to become plugged easily and in need of replacement way too often. Therefore; the filter manufactures allow a new filter to let more particles through and is only about 99% efficient when first installed. As time goes by, the dust and dirt begin to "cake" on the filter media, and it actually becomes more efficient and does a better job of cleaning the air. So, in other words, a dirty filter works better than a new one!

That's why we have a Filter Minder, so we can monitor the amount of air restriction and vacuum in the air filter canister. Knowing the amount of restriction tells us when it's time to replace it. A new filter will have an initial restriction of around 2" to 10". As it gets more restricted, it will work its way toward the red line of 25".

With the size of our air filters and the paved surfaces that we drive on, most of us could run 40-50,000 miles before our indicator would be anywhere close to the red line. With that said, the Foretravel maintenance schedule recommends air filter replacement every 2 years.

So keep an eye on your Filter Minder and if you're wondering if it's working, just push the reset button, any time, on the front of the unit to determine if it's operating correctly. It should reset back to 0" then rise back to the actual restriction level on your next road trip.

Now that you know your Filter Minder is working and how your air filter works, you can stop throwing away money on that new filter every year, and add that to your next Motorcade.

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POLICIES

POLICIES RESERVATIONS

A \$500.00 deposit per event is required at the time of reservation. Full payment is due 90 days prior to the activity start date. A second deposit may be required and is due upon billing. Reservations may be made by mail or telephone by using your MasterCard, Visa, or Discover credit card. Failure to make required payments will result in losing your place in the sign-up rotation.

CANCELLATIONS/REFUNDS

If reservations are canceled 90 days before the event, your deposits will be refunded less any unrecoverable monies retained by vendors from deposits made on member's behalf. If cancellation falls within 90 days prior to the beginning of the activity, 20% of the fees paid will be retained to cover the cost of postage, printing, supplies, bank charges, etc., plus any charges for any actual cost from guarantees and/or deposits made on member's behalf. No shows can result in no refunds. All refunds (except in very serious cases) will be charged 20% of the event fee plus actual cost from guarantees and/or deposits made on member's behalf. Some special events have their own cancellation policies.

GUESTS

Arrangements and/or registration for all guests should be made upon registration or no later than 90 days prior to the start of any event.

STANDBY LIST

Space is limited on many events. All reservations are recorded in the order initial deposits are received. If received on the same day, they are handled in a lottery style manner. When a cancellation occurs, the first on the standby list is notified to fill the opening. Do not hesitate to sign up when discovering there is a standby list for an event. Very seldom have we had any standbys remaining at the start of an event.

SCOUTING AN EVENT

This occurs approximately one year prior to running the event. Pricing and finalizing with confirmation of all tours and attractions for each event take approximately four to six months after scouting is completed. Dates are tentative. Pricing and confirmed dates will be published in the Motorcader magazine.

There is also a Car Museum nearby for those car enthusiasts.

We are hoping to have a Blue Grass band entertain us as well.







Remember that each of our rallies is a Friends Rally so members are invited to bring their RVing buddies along.




